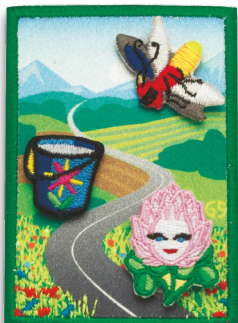

Identify shapes and patterns in natural objects, like rainbows, flowers, and leaves, and then create art inspired by nature!

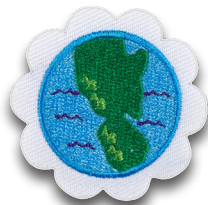
